

## Literacy

### Topic Texts Include:

'Our Class is a Family', 'What Makes Me a Me?'  
'Marvellous Me'.

Children will:

- Listen to stories with increasing attention.
- Make predictions about what a book is about and what might happen.
- Develop a phonological awareness – learn rhymes and recognising environmental sounds.
- Use print and letter knowledge to write pretend lists.

## Personal, Social, Emotional Development

Children will:

- Learn class rules and the school values.
- Share and take turns.
- Explore the indoor and outdoor environments.
- Show confidence in asking adults for help.
- Form good relationships with key person and key group.

## Physical Development

Children will:

- Build strength through large movements, e.g., climbing and running.
- Move around the space and equipment in a variety of ways and safely.
- Learn to balance and develop coordination.
- Use a range of small tools to develop hand muscles.
- Explore healthy eating habits.

## Expressive Arts and Design

Children will:

- Use different materials and techniques to explore colour and textures.
- Develop ideas when using a range of materials including construction area resources.
- Use art, music, dance, and role-play to express feelings.

- Explore families and occupations.
- Observe things in the natural environment.

- Understand 'who' questions.
- Engage with small group discussions.
- Retell familiar stories.
- Begin to form longer sentences.
- Use talk to communicate and explain own customs and traditions when discussing special times.

Our term will start with introducing the children to our School Values and their characters. We will promote positive behaviour to encourage a happy and healthy start to nursery life in Acorn Class.



### Fabulous Finish

### How you can help...
