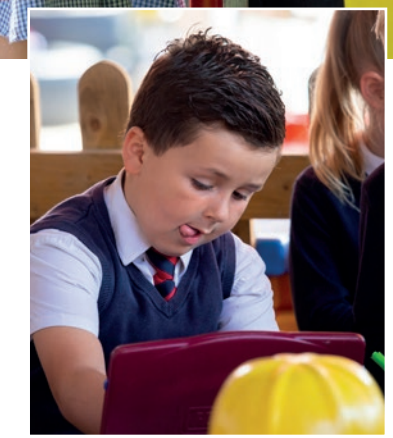

Show belief *yourself*

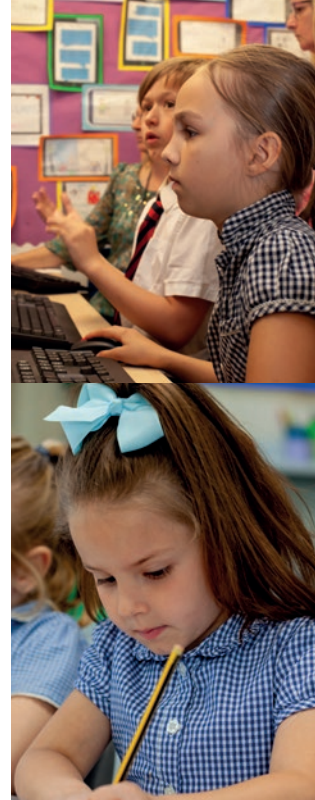
At St Katherine's, our children enjoy coming to school and have a positive and enthusiastic approach to their learning.
